In conjunction with Kerr Trailers, a quality Canadian custom trailer manufacturer, Hydrauliques Rive-Sud took on the challenge. Kerr Trailers, built the robust trailer as per specifications requested by Hydrauliques Rive-Sud. Once the trailer was completed to specs, Hydraulique Rive-Sud went to work. With its knowledgeable staff in terms of structural integrity, hydraulic and electrical experience, the crew started building the mast, bearing assembly and hydraulic reservoir. In less than four weeks after the receipt of the trailer, the crew was testing the installed mast assembly, which not only rises to 30 feet but also rotates 360 degrees. In addition, Hydrauliques Rive-Sud has incorporated a safety feature allowing the mast to rotate in case of unexpected high winds. Six weeks into the project, the trailer was delivered to Trans-Québec Audiovisuel Inc fully functional, approved by engineering experts and ready for contract work.
